We are happy to inform that our college is one of the few colleges having central research lab with equipment like HPLC, Thermo-cycler in colleges at Under Graduate level. HPLC (High Performance Liquid Chromatography) instrument and thermo-cycler give exposure to our students the contemporary developments in sciences. College has central computing facility to encourage basic research in science faculty. Our students are given the practicals using SPSS package in Statistics. Multisym is introduced to students of Electronics and Physics programmes. College had established two CALL (Computer Assisted Language Lab) facilities with all the necessary gadgets and software to impart communication skills.

## Hangouts

Well furnished spacious auditorium, seminar hall, Webinar Hall & Studio, E-class room provide ambiance for academic process on the campus. Waiting rooms and cafeteria comfort the stakeholders of the college. Knowledge exchange and information centre is a good resource in the college. Indoor stadium, gym and sprawling playground increase the fitness of the stakeholders. Computer centre, central research lab and central computing centre enhance IQ of the students.

### **Earn while you learn**

### **Mentoring system**

Each staff member acting as a Mentor will be in-charge of 25 mentorees. Student profile record is maintained in the college, which consists of all the information related to the student concerned. Under the Choice Based Credit System, the student of a programme, while pursuing the core courses of his/her programme, can choose some courses offered by the same department or other departments of the college. Students are encouraged to earn credits more than the required minimum and these extra credits are recorded in their marks statements which may help them in employment or higher studies.

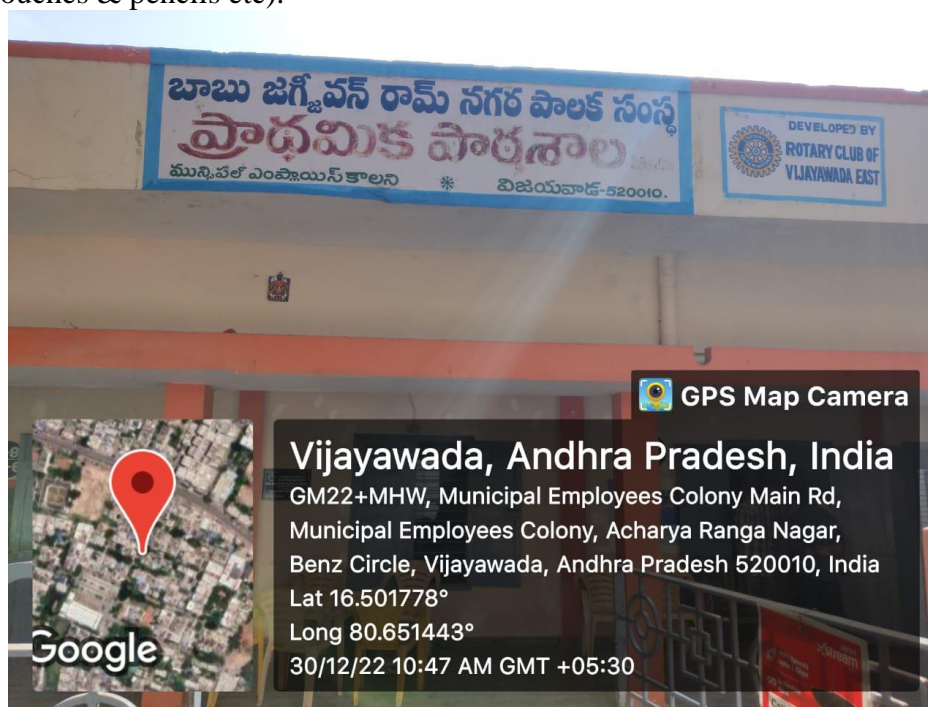
