




2. Divyangjan friendly washrooms in Main block(Geotagged)


Wash Rooms: Wash rooms and rest rooms for the faculty and staff are constructed keeping their needs in the view in maximum number and constructed with modern facilities.




3. Signage including tactile path, lights, display boards and signposts (Geotagged)




NVDA allows blind and vision impaired people to access and interact with the Windows operating system and many third party applications.


