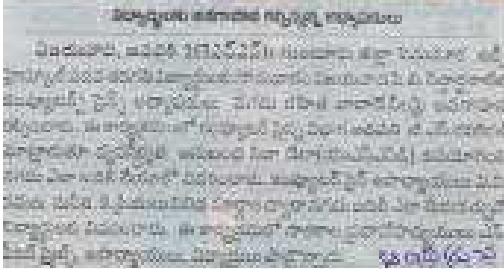






## Awareness Program on "Cashless Transactions", Penumaka
